2. Are you happy with the provision provided for Remote Learning?	Yes: 29 (85%)	No: 5 (15%)	The majority of parents and carers feel that our Remote learning provision is of a good quality. It offers a good combination of resources, including paper based resources and online learning. Teacher interaction via the zoom sessions are well received and offer children an opportunity for social interaction. Parents feel our remote learning has improved since last summer. Parents would like further zoom sessions but appreciate staff	We have increased zoom sessions for Reception children to three times a week. We will look at providing further zoom lessons for other Key Stages. This will be dependent on staffing and pupil levels in school. Teachers have offered individual zoom sessions for children if needed. Please email teachers through class emails to discuss this with them if you feel your child is struggling.
	Your comments: like zoom lessons, like a real mix of resources, loved social element of zoom, Oak Academy lessons are good, work a good quality, appreciate all the work being sent through, learning is structured with more online learning to support. 2 zooms good balance- more would be too much. Would be helpful to have: more zoom lessons, daily zoom session, significant amount of work and attachments- organised into subjects. School expectations too much.
