Class Routines and Information

Welcome back, I hope that you had a lovely Easter break and that your child is excited about coming back to school. We have many things planned for this term and I am really looking forward to continuing to work with you and your child.

Staff: I will be teaching in Hawthorn class on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday morning and Thursday afternoon. Mrs Furrugia will teach Hawthorn class on a Thursday morning and Mrs Fountain on a Friday as well as the rest of the week. On a Wednesday afternoon Miss Crowhurst will teach RE and then Mrs Churchill will teach Computing. Mrs Brookshaw is the class teaching assistant and works with us on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings. Miss Hart will be working as a SEND support assistant in our class.

Daily Routines: Children can enter the classroom from 8.45am and start the maths or spelling activity. The register will be taken at 8.55am and the first lesson will start at 9am.

Reading Books: Children should have their reading book in school every day. They will read with an adult during guided reading once a week and also on an individual basis at least once a week in the Summer term. We will ask the children a range of questions about the text they are reading so we can check their understanding of inference and language.

Library : We will go to the library on a Tuesday each week, please encourage your child to make the most of this fantastic resource we have in school.

P.E: We have two PE lessons a week (Monday and Friday). Please ensure that all items of PE kit are named and that your child has their PE kit in school every day. Many children prefer to leave it in school for the half term

Homework: Each week your child will bring home spelling words to learn (they can keep this sheet at home). They will be tested every Monday but also we will look in their work to see that they are transferring their spelling knowledge. We will have a piece of English and Maths homework on alternate weeks, given on a Thursday and due in the following Wednesday. Please encourage your child to do their best when working at home. They will bring home a maths game on a Tuesday.

Water Bottles: Children should drink throughout the day, therefore please send a named water bottle into school each Monday so that your child can have water in the classroom at the end of each lesson. The water bottle will be sent home on a Friday to be washed and returned to school the following Monday.

Snack: Children are provided with a piece of fruit in Year 2. Children may bring in a piece of fresh fruit or vegetables for their snack. Please avoid the dried, coated packets of fruit.

Topic Information for Parents

English — Quest and Adventure Stories — Children will read a range of quest stories, exploring structure and language choice. They will learn how to identify and use sentences with different forms.

Information texts - Children will explore features of information texts and write about The Great Fire of London. They will learn how to use punctuation correctly— capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.

Poetry— Children will listen to and read a range of poems of different forms.

Maths — Number and place value, addition and subtraction, money, tell time to the nearest quarter of an hour, multiplication and division, problem solving.

Geography — Seaside Holidays - To learn about geography of the UK—seas and coastlines.

History — The Great Fire of London —To learn about events that happened in the past.

Science — Plants

RE — Special places

Art — Art work related to The Great Fire of London

DT— Winding mechanisms

PSHE — Medicine and drugs

Music — Songs from Around the World

PE—Games

Computing —In the weekly computing skills lesson topics include programming, technology in our lives, handling data and online safety. Children also use computing skills across the curriculum.
