Dear Parents / Carers

I am very pleased and proud to share with you the outcome of the Phonics Check which was completed in school at the end of November. This is the check usually taken at the end of Year 1, to measure whether children can use their phonic knowledge to blend and segment up to 40 words from a list of real and nonsense words. Due to the pandemic, the check was postponed until the Autumn term, and at Harlington Lower we achieved our highest outcome ever of 85.6%. Those very few children who did not pass will have another opportunity in the Summer term. We are especially pleased with this outcome as it is evidence that our approach to the teaching of phonics is effective and that our recovery curriculum and interventions have made such positive impact. Well done children!
