We are pleased that parents want to hear about their children's achievements and their learning. Our termly curriculum overview gives an outline of each subject and the different themes or concepts that your child will be involved in during the term. Your child will be keen to share their learning experiences with you so do keep discussing this with them so you can find out more. We have an open door policy so do speak to teachers or email us for further information. We provide a class information meeting at the start of each year outlining the types of work that your child will be involved with in the coming year. We also offer parent consultation meetings in Autumn and Spring term where you have the opportunity to look at your child's work and speak to their class teacher. In July, all children's attainment and progress is discussed in their end of year report. Again, if you wish to discuss any concerns or need to ask questions please do so. We can provide parent workshops/ information sessions if there is a need so let us know any areas that you would like further support with.
